

# PVMGC Policy and Procedures

Standing rules of operation  
Set forth and implemented by the PVMGC board members  
Updated May 11, 2021

## IN THE EVENT OF A TIE

In regular Club play or non-NCGA qualifying tournaments, the computer automatically calculates the placement of teams in each flight based on the standard tie-breaker formula. Teams or individuals that are tied are compared first by the total back nine score, then the last six holes, then the last three holes. If still tied, starting at the 18th hole, then going backwards hole by hole until a winner is declared.

For NCGA qualifying tournament and the Club Championship a three-hole playoff is used to determine the qualifier and winner. **For those who qualify to move onto the NCGA qualifier the club will do the registration for you, you do not need to register yourself.**

## IN THE EVENT OF A TIE During Covid 19

In regular Club play or non-NCGA qualifying tournaments, the computer automatically calculates the placement of teams in each flight based on the standard tie-breaker formula. Teams or individuals that are tied are compared first by the total back nine score, then the last six holes, then the last three holes. If still tied, starting at the 18th hole, then going backwards hole by hole until a winner is declared.

**For NCGA qualifying tournament and the Club Championship we will use the same procedure as listed above, there will be no three-hole playoff to determine the qualifier and winner. For those who qualify to move onto the NCGA qualifier the club will do the registration for you, you do not need to register yourself.**

## Hole in One fund

**This is insurance only!** In the event of a member making an ACE during a sanctioned PVMGC tournament the PVMGC will cover the bar tab up to \$350.00 per incident. Limit is one well or small draft beer only per player. The member making the ACE will receive any monies left over if any up to the \$350.00. This insurance does not include any tips, that is the responsibility of the player that is getting the drink.

## Skins carry over, no winner/s

All prizes in that skin game will be carried over to the next month's tournament and added to the total prize for that tournament and divided amongst the winners of that skin regardless of participation in previous months skins. The prizes will be carried over until such time that we have a winner/s.

### **NCGA Net Amateur**

This tournament no longer requires club official registration so it is open to all who would like to enter. PVMGC will hold a random drawing and select two club members in good standing so they can have entry fees provided for by the club. The club will register for you, you do not need to register yourself.

The drawing will be held after the completion and scoring of the July tournament. All members who played in any tournaments during the year will be eligible so there is no need to enter, the board will enter your name into the drawing and give you one entry for each tournament you played in from November previous year to July of current year. Good luck and you will be notified by email if we draw your name. So, if you played in every tournament, you would have 9 entries into the drawing and so on.

If you choose to sign up for the USGA Net Amateur on your own and choose to represent the PVMGC and do qualify to move on, the PVMGC club will not pay your entry fees to continue and you must register yourself, the club will not do this for you.

### **Wrong score signed for**

Once you finish your round of golf and have signed for the score that was recorded for you by the scorer it becomes record. Please make sure you go over the hole-by-hole scores that were recorded. Adjust and correct before signing your card. The hole score counts and is final, adding the holes to get a wrong total score does not matter, it is just a checks and balance for the board member entering scores into record.

If you turn in your card and do not sign it as being scored and or checked then that is grounds for Disqualification. Score cards must be signed off.

If the signed card has wrong hole score/s that were higher then you had on hole/s, those scores are final, this is not cause for Disqualification.

If the signed card has wrong hole score/s that were lower, then you actually had on hole/s then that score is final, this will result in you being Disqualified for wrong hole scores.
